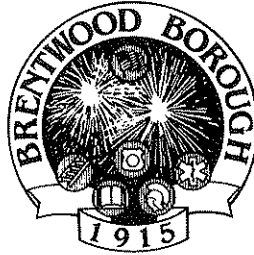

On Saturday, June 5, 2010, Brentwood Borough in conjunction with the Brentwood Business Owners' Association has scheduled its "**Annual Community Clean-Up Day**" in Brentwood Park from 8:00 A.M. to 2:00 P.M., which will coincide with "World Environmental Day."

"**Spread the News and Clean-Up the Town.**" As in the past, the day will begin with the following items that can be dropped off at the parking lot in Brentwood Park for a Community Clean-up:

- Tires -(No Rims)
- Large Brush/Clippings 4" or less (No Logs)
- Scrap Metal & Aluminum
- Construction Materials Including Larger Items.
- Old Gas Grills, Lawn Mowers (Gasoline & Oil must be removed)
- Refrigerators and Air Conditioners (Freon must be removed and item properly tagged)

As the residents prepare to unload and discard old/broken items at Brentwood Park, workers and volunteers will be there to check "Proof of Residency" and assist the residents.

**In an effort to make this annual event successful**, the Borough is seeking volunteers from all the organizations within the Borough to take part and assist in the "Clean Sweep" along Brownsville Road by gathering and disposing of debris on the sidewalks and along the curb/gutters. With participation from each organization, it would be a great way for the members to earn points for a badge or to just work alongside one of their friends while contributing to the community. **We ask the volunteers to meet 8:00 A.M., at the Community Room and prepare to disperse equally along each side of Brownsville Road, some walking toward Sankey Avenue and others toward Towne Square; therefore, covering all of Brownsville Road throughout the Borough.**

**Not only are we requesting volunteers**, we are also seeking property owners, residential and commercial, to take the time to check their properties and discard all unwanted items that may be stacked on the porch, along a wall/driveway and that may no longer be useful.
